Following the Joint Declaration on the European Alliance for Apprenticeships, the DGB has submitted concrete commitments via ETUC - *European Trade Unions Confederation* - to reform, develop and enhance apprenticeship systems in Europe.

Essentially is to raise the awareness on the added value apprenticeships among employers and youth, to disseminate information and take action on more attractive conditions for corporations and apprentices.

The project initiative has been set up to promote sustainable trade union cooperation in vocational training and to integrate them into dialogue processes of the relevant actors on the ground.

The project is sponsored by German Federal Ministry of Education and Science to achieve these goals:

- To disseminate the apprenticeship's tools among young people and companies
- Networking and promoting cooperation in partner countries
- To build pilot projects between partners (Portugal, Italy, Greece, Slovakia and Latvia)
- To improve the learning processes and training dialogues to create a quality framework and provide minimum standards in the European Union
